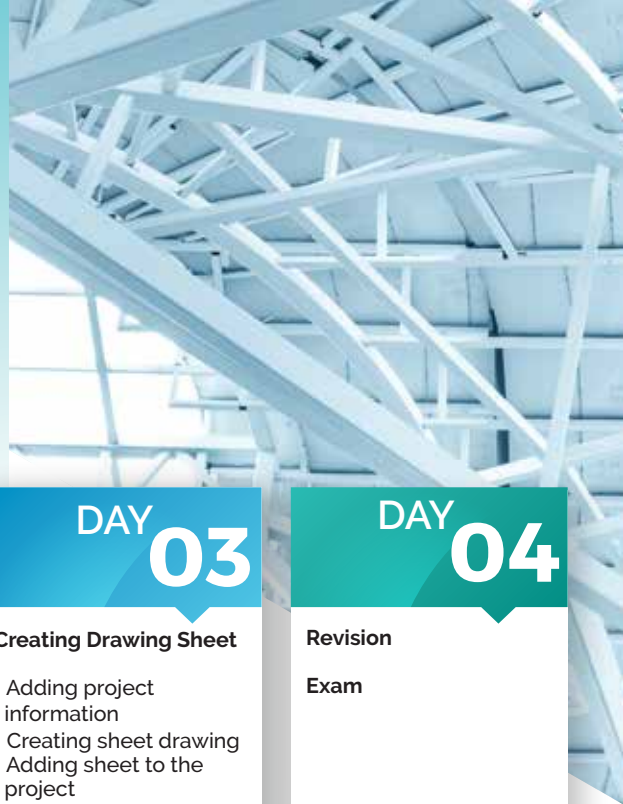
- Operate a 3D parametric modelling tool
